## TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN ORDINANCE NO. <u>01-2010</u>

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE UNIFORM STANDARDS FOR THE NAMING OF ROADS; AND ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES FOR THE SHESHEQUIN TOWNSHIP AND RENAMING CERTAIN ROADS AND RENUMBERING CERTAIN ADDRESSES.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN that the following ordinance is adopted to provide for an orderly method of naming and numbering public and private Roads and roadways in SHESHEQUIN TOWNSHIP.

#### I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to support the County of Bradford Enhanced 9-1-1 / Emergency Communications System to assist fire, rescue, ambulance companies, law enforcement agencies, the United States Postal Service, and the public in the timely and efficient provision of services to residents and businesses of Bradford County. This Ordinance will rename and renumber certain Roads to comply with said Policy.

## II. IMPLEMENTATION AND ADMINISTRATION

This ordinance is established in conjunction with the County of Bradford in implementing and developing a "Master Road Address Guide" and coordinating, designating and naming of addresses pursuant to the Road naming and address policy. Enforcement of the ordinance shall remain the responsibility of the TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN; however, the County of Bradford shall coordinate and assist the TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN in enforcement.

#### III. GUIDELINES AND STANDARDS

The TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN shall establish Road names as chosen by the TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN, or land developer or land owner, and Road or house numbers in accordance with the guidelines as amended and as set forth and described in Exhibit "A": BRADFORD COUNTY ROAD NAMING AND ADDRESSING POLICY. Establishment of any Road names and addresses will be coordinated with the County of Bradford pursuant to the Road Naming and Addressing Policy. The designation of Road names and addresses by the TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN shall be submitted to the County of Bradford so as to coordinate such designations and to comply with the County of Bradford Road Naming and Addressing Policy. Sheshequin Township adopts the Bradford County Road Naming and Addressing Policy as part of this Ordinance.

#### IV. ENFORCEMENT

- A. Whenever the TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN has reason to believe there has been a violation of any provision of this ordinance, TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN, or the designee of the TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN, shall give notice to the person or party failing to comply and order said person or party to take corrective action or measures within thirty (30) days from the date of notification.
- B. If such person or party fails to comply with the duly issued order, TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN, or the designee of the TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN, shall initiate necessary actions to terminate the violation through criminal and/or civil measures.
- C. Penalties Any violation of any provision of this ordinance pursuant to any criminal section shall constitute a summary offense, punishable by a maximum fine of \$300.00 per offense. Subsequent to the thirty (30) day period following a notification of violation, each day of

violation shall constitute a separate violation. Should pursuant to this section, enforcement be by civil measures, any civil sanctions to be imposed shall be at a similar rate to the criminal in the amount of a maximum of \$300.00 per offense with each day of violation constituting a separate violation

D. TOWNSHIP OF SHESHEQUIN shall have the authority and option, per agreement with Bradford County, should both parties choose to do so, to designate Bradford County as designee for purposes of enforcement.
