## RESOLUTION <u>03-2010</u> SHESHEQUIN TOWNSHIP



AND NOW, this  $12^{th}$  day of <u>April 2010</u>, the Sheshequin Township Supervisors, at a duly advertised meeting of the Sheshequin Township Supervisors adopts the foregoing Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Sheshequin Township Supervisors is a body corporate and political existing by virtue of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, (hereinafter referred to as "Township"); and

WHEREAS, the Sheshequin Township Supervisors recognize that different driveway and road encroachments will cause additional expense to the Township by way of said roadway encroachment and the need to insure the roadway is restored to its original conditions, and:

WHEREAS, Sheshequin Township reserve the right to set the fee for said Driveway Permit by resolution; and

WHEREAS, any change of location will require a new permit; and

WHEREAS, an original permit shall be valid for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of issuance; and

WHEREAS, a renewal permit may be requested prior to the expiration of the original permit and said renewal permit shall be valid for a twelve (12) month period from the date of issuance; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sheshequin Township Supervisors may adopt a Resolution for the Driveway Permits for the Sheshequin Township residents; and

WHEREFORE, the Sheshequin Township Supervisors shall charge a permit fee for Driveway Permits in accordance with Ordinance Chapter <u>04-01</u>, Driveways, as follows:

## The fees shall be based on the width of the driveway as set forth below:

30 feet width of driveway or less the rate shall be \$25:

31 feet and above for the width of the driveway shall be \$3 per foot for every foot;

For example:

31 feet would be a \$93 fee.

100 feet would be a \$300 fee

The signature of the property owner (s) shall be required on the Driveway Permit application. The permit which is valid for twelve (12) months may be renewed for an additional twelve (12) months at a renewal fee of \$30.

WHEREFORE, the Sheshequin Township Supervisors establish the above rates effective April 12, 2010.
